Horse Race is Back! August 7th, 8th

For the first time in many years, the Horse Race golf event is back. Joe Enloe has organized this special event which will begin with a covered dish dinner on Friday evening August 7th at 6:00 P.M. After dinner, you can bid on your "Horse", (golfer) by buying them for the next day's event. Details on the rules

will be explained the night of the event. To briefly explain how it works, golfers with similar handicaps tee off in a group on the same hole. Each hole the golfer with the highest score on the hole, drops out of the "Race". If there is a tie for high score, there is a chip off to see who stays. At the

end, there will be one golfer (horse) remaining who is the champion of their division. Payouts will be made for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each group. The cost for players to enter is \$20.00. Signup sheets are located in the clubhouse. You may must be signed up before the bidding process begins. Gary Craig will be our head auctioneer for the evening. Come out and enjoy this special event.

Senior Junior Cup Match set for August 29th, 30th

The second annual Senior Junior cup match event will be held August 29th and 30th.

This Ryder Cup style golf match event features members of Spring Creek Golf Club. Seniors, age 65 & up who tee off from the Black tees, take on the Junior golfers (below age

65) who tee off from the white tee markers.

Saturday is a scramble format for one point per team and Sunday is a Four ball partner match for one point per team.

There will be a dinner on Friday evening to see who will be paired against who. This event is open to any golf member of the club

who wants to play. Signup sheets are located in the clubhouse.

This event was a great deal of fun last year which ended in a tie after two days of play. The Juniors won an exciting four hole playoff. This year is set for an exciting match as the Seniors are geared up and ready for a rematch!
